The Cable Tow will be open on Sat 14^{th} Sep from 09:00-11:00am for practice riding. Rider's briefing will be held at 11:00am sharp – all riders must be present for this!

As team captain, I will ensure that both my team members are competent riders and in good overall health. We will both wear a floatation device at all times and a helmet on the Cable Tow. Riders will be instructed to not attempt any tricks which are beyond their comfortable skill level.

TAG, TEAM CABLE EVENT

The Format:

Each team of 2 riders will get 15 minutes on the Cable Tow between them. Only 1 teammember may be on the water at any time. There will be up to 2 other teams sharing the cable for this time. Get in as many tricks as possible! The more unique tricks the pair do, the more points they will score. The pair share a score sheet so must not repeat their team mate's tricks. Points are given for surface tricks, features and air tricks. If you fall, run back to the start and TAG your team mate back in before they can hit the water! Each team member must do a minimum of 2 laps each or the team will not score. At the end of the session the score sheets will be added up and the top 3 teams will advance to the final.

The finals follow the same format as the qualifying rounds, but now there are only 3 teams on the lake. The time limit is shortened to 10 minutes for this round so choose your tricks wisely!

In this round each team member must do a minimum of 1 lap each or face not scoring.

The cable speed will be run at 31 KPH. Handles will not be taped up.

The Rewards:

Open categories will have prize money.
All other categories will have prizes provided by our wonderful sponsors!

Cost:

The cost to enter the competition is £40 per person which will include a warm up session on the cable, an entry pack and your competition time.

Categories:

- Junior Ladies: Both riders must be under 18yrs, both riders must be female.
- Junior Men's: Both riders must be under 18yrs, mixed teams allowed.
- Master's: Both riders must be over 30yrs, mixed teams allowed.
- Open Ladies: Both riders must be female; any age may choose to enter.
- Open Men's: Any team that does not fit into an above category Any team can choose to enter this category.

Note: You can score points on a wake skate in any of the above categories.

How to Enter:

Complete an application form which can be collected from our Activities Reception or downloaded from www.boxendpark.com/cable-tow and submit before Wednesday 11th September. The teams riding times on the cable will be posted on the day of the competition.

On the day of the event you must register with your team no later than 10:30am at main reception.

The cable will be open from 09:00 – 11:00am for normal riding. A rider's briefing held at 11:00am – all riders should be present for this.
